As a reminder, according to the CDC, COVID-19 is spread by person-to-person contact. Here are some simple ways you can reduce your chances of being infected or spreading COVID-19:

- Clean your hands often. If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a bent elbow or tissue when you cough or sneeze.
- Maintain at least 3 feet (1 meter) of distance between yourself and anyone who is coughing or sneezing.
- If you have a fever, cough, or difficulty breathing, stay home unless to seek medical care.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces regularly throughout the day.
- Keep up to date on the latest COVID-19 hotspots, and avoid travel.
